## 4<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS BUY POLSKA – BUY KRAKOW

**KRAKOW, POLAND 1-5 NOVEMBER 2023**

### **1<sup>st</sup> Nov Wed Day 1. Arrivals to Krakow**

*all day* Arrivals to Krakow. Check-in at Plus Q 4\*\*\*\* hotel, Wygrana 9, tel. 0048 12 333 40 20, centrally located. Free time. Overnight in Krakow. No dinner included.

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Nov Thu Day 2. Krakow – conference (conference's lectures will be communicated later on) and B2B**

7.30 Buffet breakfast at the hotel.

8.30 Registration of the participants, preparations for the opening.

9.00 Congress opening ceremony.

11.00 Coffee break.

11.30 B2B – meetings with the local expositors – sanctuaries, local informations offices, places of interest, local companies.

14.00 Lunch.

15.00 Visit of Krakow with a local guide. The old capital of the Polish Kingdom, one of the Europe's biggest empires in the Middle Ages: we will walk up the Wawel Hill to see the Royal Castle and the Cathedral – the place of coronation and last resting of many Polish kings. We will then continue to the Old Town with its lively Main Market Square Rynek – the biggest medieval market square in Europe, embellished by many monuments, including the Cloth Hall Sukiennice and the Saint Mary Church with its fine wooden altar carved by the medieval master, Wit Stwosz. Krakow Old Town was declared the World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1978. We will also visit places related to Karol Wojtyła, the archbishop of Krakow, such as the Franciscan Church, the „Papal Window” at the Archbishop's Palace and other places.

20.00 Dinner in the restaurant with a klezmer music concert.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Nov Fri Day 3. Krakow – Auschwitz-Birkenau – Czestochowa – Krakow**

7.30 Buffet breakfast at the hotel.

8.15 Transfer to Auschwitz-Birkenau.

10.00 Guided tour at the former German Nazi concentration camp in Auschwitz-Birkenau. The camp was built by the Germans during the German occupation of Poland. More than a million people from different nationalities were killed in this place, the majority of Jewish origin. Today this place is listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

- 13.00 Lunch in a restaurant.  
 14.00 Departure to Czestochowa.  
 16.00 The sanctuary of Black Madonna with its famous painting (said to be the work of St John) is a symbolic place for all the Poles. Along many, sometimes difficult, centuries of the Polish country, the Polish would come and still come here to ask for help of the Blessed Virgin. The Mother of God was pronounced the Queen of Poland by the King John Casimirus in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. It is one of the main European pilgrimage destinations, receiving between 3 and 4 million of pilgrims every year. The Sanctuary is also a fortress, an interesting architectural complex.  
 19.00 Dinner in a restaurant.  
 20.00 Return to Krakow. Overnight in Krakow.

**4<sup>th</sup> Nov Sat Day 4. Krakow – Kalwaria Zebrzydowska – Wadowice – Wieliczka – Krakow**

- 7.00 Buffet breakfast at the hotel.  
 8.00 Transfer to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska.  
 9.00 Visit at the Bernardine Monastery in Kalwaria, the 3<sup>rd</sup> most famous shrine in Poland. The whole Mannerist complex (including the sanctuary and a park) is also listed as a World Heritage site by UNESCO. Karol Wojtyla would visit this place since his childhood, kept coming even as a Pope.  
 9.45 Departure to Wadowice.  
 10.30/11.00 Visit to the Parish church of Wadowice where Karol Wojtyla was baptised. Continue to the museum of John Paul II, recently renovated and reopened, a place that tells the story of the Greatest of the Poles, from his early years in small multicultural town of Wadowice until his last days as a bishop of Rome.  
 13.00 Lunch in a restaurant.  
 14.00 Transfer to Krakow and a short visit of the Shrine of the Divine Mercy in Lagiewniki.  
 16.15 Transfer to Wieliczka.  
 17.00 We visit Wieliczka to see the oldest salt mine in Europe. Wieliczka is a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created an underground world of tunnels and underground salt lakes with a rich interior of decorated chapels including the famous Saint Kunegunda Chapel, plus other galleries and works made of salt. Wieliczka is one the most beautiful places listed by UNESCO in Poland.  
 20.00 Final dinner with a folclore music concert. Return to the hotel. Overnight in Krakow.

**5<sup>th</sup> Nov Sun Day 5. Krakow: departures**

- morning* Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Check out. Departures by your own.

**Participation fees:**

**Price per person in a twin, double or triple room:** 300 Eur.

**Price per person in a SGL room:** 400 Eur.
